Camping Equipment (not a complete list)

Tent (No campers or trailers – Tent only camping)

Sleeping Bag and extra blanket

EARPLUGS! *There can be lots of Road Noise at some sites*

Flashlight, lanterns

Extra Clothing including for Warm and Cold Weather

Cooking Equipment and extra Food (Pack is only providing Dinner on Saturday Evening)

Bug Spray and Sunscreen

Toilet Paper

Hand Wipes (Baby wipes are great for this)

Class A and Class B Uniform (**No Neckerchief or sliders required**)

Ponchos, goggles/Protective Eye Wear, Flour Bombs (Pre-made)

Crawdad fishing (**No Crawdad traps allowed for competition**)

Fishing Pole / Bamboo stick / Branch

Fishing Line and optional hooks

Bait (Slim Jims, Hot Dogs, Bacon, Chicken all work well)

Pocket Knife if your scout has earned their Whittling Chip which they must carry

Firewood if you want your own camp area fire

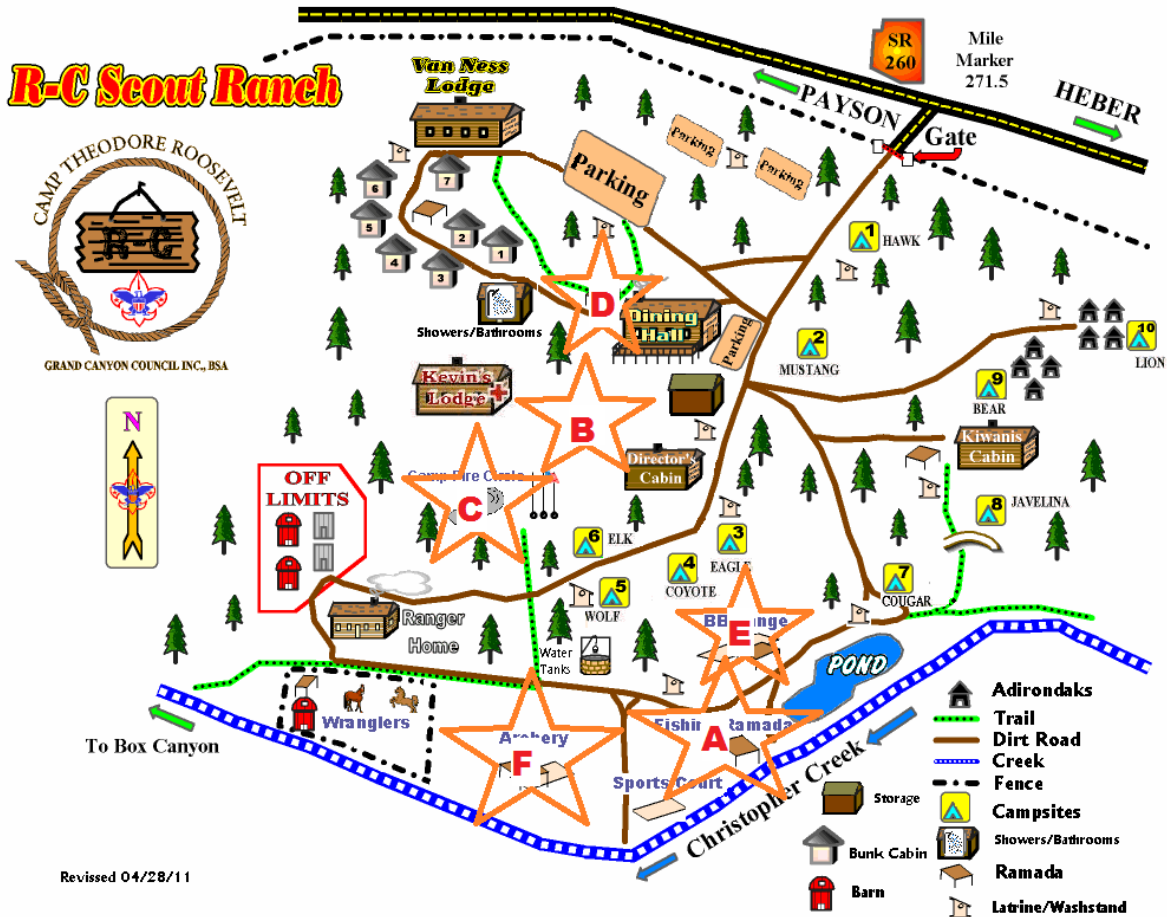

Camp Safety

The Buddy System

- Everyone has a buddy.
- Your buddy goes everywhere with you, and you go everywhere with him.
- Know where your buddy is at all times.

The buddy system is important. If you get hurt or lost, your buddy will be able to help you. Two people can often solve a problem better than one.

- Cub Scouts must always use the “Buddy System”
- First Aid Kits are available from most Den Leaders and the Cub Master who will be centrally located
- No fires outside the designated fire rings
- Stick to Trails
- Watch out for wildlife, do not leave food out around the camp site
- Practice Leave No Trace at all times
