To register a Cub you must have:

- Name
- Rank at time of camp
- DOB
- Pack #
- Contact's email and phone #
- Cub's family email - for medical form and messages
- Payment- Credit Card, echeck, PayPal



To register an Adult or Den Chief you must have:

- Name
- DOB
- Pack #
- Contact's email and phone #-for medical form and messages
- Fee- Free!

You must provide an adult leader for every 1-5 boys who attend camp! A Den Chief is optional. You may rotate leadership.

Registration is on a first come first serve basis due to limited spaces. There will be no refunds. Walk-in registration fee is \$85.00 if space is available.

Den sizes vary from 8-12 Cub Scouts. Webelos will be in separate dens from Tigers, Wolves and Bears.



Orientation: Saturday, May 16, 2009 at 9:00 a.m. at the Heard Scout Pueblo.

All adults and Den Chiefs that will be attending camp are requested to be at Day Camp orientation or you may send one representative from your Pack if needed.

What to Bring to Camp

Water Bottle or Canteen

Be prepared for the heat. Drink lots of water and bring spray bottles. Spray bottles are also available for purchase at the Trading Post.

Bring Sack Lunch Everyday

Sandwiches must not have mayonnaise or be made with anything that might spoil. Each Den is furnished 2 ice chests and one bag of ice to store lunches.

Any and All Medicines

Must be brought to the medical personnel at camp headquarters, labeled with your name, and instructions, for use and dosage.

Uniform, Bathing Suits, Sun Block and Towels

The day camp uniform is the day camp T-shirt and headwear, your own swimming suit, and closed toe shoes. Your cub day camp uniform is required to participate each day. Swimming suits should be worn underneath shorts (adults too) because there is not enough time to change.

Trading Post

Snacks, sodas, pirate loot and souvenirs will be available for purchase. We suggest each camper bring \$3-5 per day for trading post items.

What Not to Bring to Camp

*NO OPEN TOED SHOES ALLOWED

*Non-participants are not permitted to be in camp. Only parents, leaders, Den Chiefs and Cub Scouts who fill out an application form may participate in camp program areas.

*No cutoffs are allowed in the pool.

Den Competition

Awards will be presented for best den flag, best den site decorations, guessing game and early birds (on time). Bring materials to decorate your den area and flag (provided).

Camperships

Camperships are available for campers in need of assistance. Up to 75% of the fee may be sponsored. Contact the Council Program Office at (602) 955-7747, ext. 219 for an application or additional information before April 1, 2008.

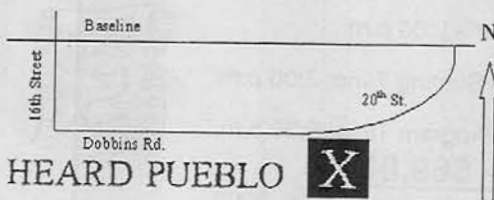
