Webelos can work on the requirements for the Forester, Geologist, Naturalist, Aquanaut and Outdoorsman activity badges. Other activities include earning the BB Gun and Archery belt loops or boating on our lake. Free time can be spent hiking scenic mountain trails or roasting marshmallows over a glowing campfire.

## Fees for 2009

The fee for the Webelos Encampment is \$170.00\* per Webelos and \$130.00\* per Adult. A \$25.00 non-refundable deposit per person is required for you and your Webelos Scout to make a reservation. - Webelos Scouts may register as individuals, by dens or by packs. At least one adult (21 years of age or older) must attend for every five youth. All adults will have the opportunity to participate in all the programs.
- A current *Personal Health and Medical Record* will be required for all youth and adults attending the Webelos Encampment. Youth and adults under 40 must have had a physical examination within the last three years, adults 40 and over within the past year. A Medical Form will be mailed to you upon registration.
- Please complete and mail the registration form below to the Council Service Center by July 10, 2009. Make checks payable to BSA.
- Once your reservation is received, you will be sent more details about your Webelos Encampment. Information will include what to bring, medical forms, arrival dates and times, and detailed directions to Camp Geronimo.

# About Camp Geronimo

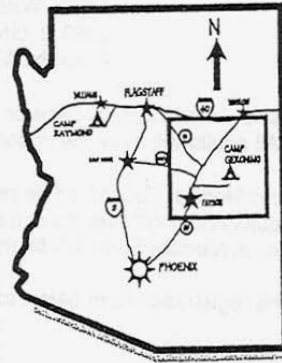


Located in the magnificent Mogollon Rim on nearly 200 acres of forest and meadows, camp Geronimo is surrounded by over 5,000 acres of undisturbed ponderosa forest in the Webber Creek water shed. Trails lead from camp taking Scouts to the top of the rim, where they can stand at the very edge of the Colorado Plateau and view hundreds of square miles of the Tonto National Forest.

Geronimo has 29 campsites, a swimming pool, small lake, craft center, archery range, BB Gun range, and a stable of horses. One of the finest camps in the Western Region, Geronimo brings one of the best staffs together to deliver an exceptional camp program.



## How to get there



Leaving the Phoenix metropolitan area, take State Highway 87 north. After reaching Payson, continue on Highway 87 about 12 miles until you reach the Control Road turn-off marked by highway marker 265, turn right. Continue on the control Road (dirt) for seven miles, then turn left onto Camp Geronimo road and into camp. Allow 2 1/2 to 3 hours driving time.
